- Re-delivery of the Level 1 cohort from previous MAMP project
- ... for three cohorts!

Level 2 Cohort

- The next step after Level 1
- Developed to target cohort interest from previous MAMP project
- Attended by "graduates" of the previous Level 1 Cohorts
- Topics: Defining levels of service, articulating the cost of service delivery for selected service areas

Common to Level 1 and Level 2: A focus on implementation of asset management, supported by technical assistance.

THE PROCESS

LEVEL 1

- One to three staff per municipality (even one Councilor in attendance)
- Three workshops, all virtual
 - Timing of workshops adjusted to suit virtual delivery

LEVEL 2

- One to three staff per municipality (though we always welcomed more!)
- Three workshops, all virtual
 - Workshops 1, 2A, 2B, 3
 - Timing of workshops to suit virtual, and promote implementation
- Highlighted case studies of cohort participants
 - County of Forty Mile: What does it cost to operate and maintain our roads?




THE LESSONS LEARNED

- Management of four cohorts all running at the same time
- Transition to virtual workshops
 - Zoom facilitator
 - Time, and timing
- Balance between group learning format and individual, tailored support
- · Cohort format promotes small communities of practice, focused on implementation
- Check-ins between workshops helped to maintain momentum
- Start where you are and take small steps


Level of Understanding Asset Management

My municipality improved its asset management capacity as a result of attending this program





Knowledge sharing - so we're not starting from scratch.






The group would most benefit from asset management education in my municipality is






The areas of asset management that are least understood in my municipality are






The training group that would work best for me is
