Municipal Asset Management Program

- MAMP is a five-year, \$50 million grant program provided by the Government of Canada and administered by FCM
- Earlier in 2018, IAMA, RMA and AUMA delivered asset management training to municipal elected officials and staff across Alberta with a grant from this program
- The same partnership applied for and received another round of funding in the summer to develop and deliver an asset management group learning project



Municipal Asset Management Program

- The project will include six to ten municipalities participating in cohort based learning
- Objective is progress on the MAMP Asset Management Readiness Scale.
- Legacy training resources will allow for other municipalities to benefit.
- Project team is currently deciding on a consultant to lead the group learning project.



Municipal Asset Management Program

- We will be seeking participating municipalities for the project very soon. Any municipality will be eligible to apply to participate, but we will be prioritizing smaller municipalities with limited asset management capacity.
- We expect the actual group learning to kick off in January or February 2019 and wrap up in the fall of 2019.
